After that, we watched videos of some parts of ancient Greek drama performed by the theatrical group of our school

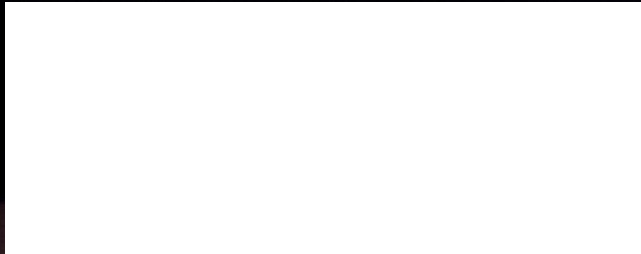
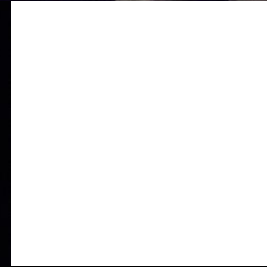
