

 - We stick a lot of colorful fabric lanes in the plastic net with the stapler.
 - We take the colors and the papers and draw a face as we like.
 - We take a lane of paper and stick it with the stapler, so that we can make a nose and we paint it.
 - At the end, we stick the face in the plastic net with stapler.
